

WE NEED YOUR ACTION NOW—MORE THAN EVER

Fellow Life Defender,

Ever since the Supreme Court overturned *Roe v. Wade* last summer - returning the right to regulate abortion to the American people - certain groups have been working around the clock to insert extreme, pro-abortion language into state constitutions across America. Just a couple months ago, our neighboring state of Minnesota codified abortion up to birth, for any reason, into their state constitution. Not only did they pass this legislation, proponents openly rejected offered amendments to provide unborn children some basic protections.


Here is what's concerning: **South Dakota is a current target.** Emboldened by their success in 2022, these same radical groups have placed South Dakota directly in their crosshairs. They have already begun circulating a petition to place a state constitutional right to abortion on the 2024 South Dakota ballot. **Let me be clear: the threat to unborn children in South Dakota is real and imminent.** This proposed state constitutional amendment is far more extreme than *Roe v. Wade* itself: Abortion would be legalized from conception to birth. Informed consent protections would be banned. Conscience protections for life-affirming doctors and nurses would be banned. Medical professionals could be forced to perform abortions against their will or face repercussions. Parental notification laws would be banned. **This measure is far too extreme and presents a grave threat to unborn life and families.**

So what can you do? It's simple: decline to sign the petition. Do not let yourself, your family or your friends be fooled by these petition circulators standing outside venues like libraries, court houses, sporting events and nursing homes misrepresenting this proposed constitutional right to abortion as "pro-life" and "pro-family."
