every other week throughout the summer and helped with a wide variety of tasks: spackling and painting walls, yard work, installing essential new tech equipment, organizing baby item donations and getting packets of information ready for supporters and volunteers.

When the first COVID-19 cases were confirmed in South Dakota, this need became even more essential. Lou has always completed her tasks with joy and has been an incredible blessing to the staff, volunteers and clients who benefit from being able to use a safe, clean space. Many companies pay up to \$500 a month for cleaning, and our team is humbled by Lou's willingness to volunteer her time for this task.
