
Too often our clients are led to think, based on TV, romance novels, social media or friends, that intimate physical involvement is the very definition of love.


However, when they come in our door, these valued young people are offered the life-changing, counter-cultural message that they are not finding on Snapchat, YouTube or their Instagram feed.



- We distributed over 180,000 booklets and brochures to our affiliates in 2019. Our affiliates are located in all 50 states and are comprised of parents, educators and pregnancy centers like Alpha Center.


