LETTER FROM THE FOUNDER

I feel bad for our postal workers, I really do. The fact that every workday includes the possibility they are indirectly participating in the death of an unborn life is heartbreaking. Our nation is changing at an incredible pace. **These days, you can buy pretty much anything online.** I'll be honest, I love the instant access to exactly what I am needing - purchased and shipped to me with the click of a button.

In this day and age, why wouldn't someone shop for an abortion online? The abortion industry got smart last year. Under the guise of COVID-19 precautions, they convinced the FDA to relax the requirements for purchasing abortion pills online. Apparently it was too unsafe to require these women to come in and have their pregnancy confirmed through an ultrasound before prescribing a chemical abortion. Now, thanks to our current administration, the relaxed requirements still stand even though we are past needing to take extreme precautions against the spread of COVID-19.

So what's next? I have to believe the abortion industry will only strengthen their efforts to champion widespread abortion access using whatever means necessary. In fact, they have even started marketing it as "medication abortion" because who hasn't taken medicine at some point? For many of us, taking pills at home is just a normal part of life.

My heart absolutely breaks for these women, many of whom experience psychological effects after going through an abortion at home, oftentimes alone. Or what about the girls in their college dorm rooms this fall? Or the women that are being forced to take these pills by their pimps or partners who are now able to purchase them online?

Much like the abortion industry, our strategy has changed too. While we would love to be able to intercept every woman considering an abortion before she has made a decision to end her pregnancy, we realize this can't always be the case.

However, what if we could offer a small glimmer of hope to the woman right in the middle of her abortion? You see, to complete a chemical abortion, a woman needs to take two different pills about 24-72 hours apart from each other. It's during this short time frame between pills that she could change her mind. If she does, we are here to help.

It's called *Abortion Pill Rescue*, and we have the means necessary to offer this service to women in our community. In fact, in the past several months, we have successfully begun the rescue process with multiple women who have taken the first abortion pill and then regretted their decision. Please pray for them and their unborn babies in the months to come.

The battle is just beginning. About half of the recorded abortions last year were chemical abortions and I only anticipate that number will continue to rise. The fight to make abortion unthinkable is not a battle we fight alone – we invite your participation and support.

Was any of this information a shock to you? Do you feel uninformed about what is going on? My friends in the pregnancy help movement created a fabulous, short docuseries to help spread the word about the danger of chemical abortions, and I strongly recommend watching the docuseries by visiting this ischemical abortion.com. Trust me, it's worth your precious time.

We need to let these women know that it's not too late and that there is still hope. I invite your partnership so that you can personally help rescue an unborn baby fighting for his or her life.

In the fall of 2020, Darold fell off a ladder while working at home and broke his leg. With a boot and scooter, Darold still felt called to serve. His first event with his new accessories was helping at our annual fundraising dinner by greeting and directing guests to their seats. Within a week, Darold was out again representing Alpha Center at the South Dakota Right to Life Convention. His service is a humbling example to our staff and other volunteers, and if there is ever a challenge, we can always rely on him to overcome it with perseverance, a smile and some light-hearted humor.

Fully healed from his broken leg, Darold continues to volunteer regularly. He kicked off 2021 by traveling to Pierre with two staff members to visit with state legislators and other pregnancy resource centers. He also served at the Knight to Remember by greeting all mother and son attendees at the door and announcing their arrival in honorable fashion. For numerous events like our annual dinners, he has graciously offered to store and transport our event materials in his enclosed trailer. Additionally, he mentors young men in our Fatherhood mentoring program and spends a considerable amount of time on building maintenance, seasonal decorating and landscaping projects.

One of Darold's biggest contributions this year was helping with our new carpet installation. He led the volunteer group in moving furniture and removing the old carpet. It was during this time that Darold's mother-in-law passed away, and yet he stayed committed to seeing the project through. One night he even brought several family members that were here visiting from out of town to finish putting all the furniture and décor back in place after the new carpet had been installed. Darold is an incredibly dedicated individual and his servant heart further inspires us to continue our daily work and, likewise, show the same care and thoughtfulness to our clients.


