Kayli's Story

Kayli still remembers the moment she found Alpha Center. She had been searching online, looking for answers after discovering she was pregnant. When she came through our doors, she was honest about how she felt: *drained, scared, and overwhelmed*. The early days of her pregnancy were marked by intense morning sickness that made even the simplest tasks feel impossible.

And yet, even in the middle of that hardship, Kayli and the father of the baby, Jacob, made a **brave and beautiful decision**.

While still completing high school, Kayli embraced motherhood and met challenges she never expected to face. When she learned she was carrying not one baby, but **two**, the weight of it all felt even heavier. She shared how nervous she was, not just to become a mom, but to become a mom to twins.

With support from Alpha Center, she was connected to prenatal care and began participating in our Earn While You Learn program. Lesson by lesson, she and Jacob prepared to be parents. Kayli shared honestly about her fears, even asking for guidance on something as practical as managing two newborn sleep schedules. Birthing classes were also provided to the couple to prepare for the arrival of their sons.

At just 33 weeks, Kayli and Jacob welcomed identical twin boys into the world, each weighing a tiny but mighty three pounds. She named them Shilo, meaning *peaceful one*, and Hosa, meaning *raven*.

Throughout the program, they earned Baby Bucks, allowing them to shop for the items needed **times two**. From car seats to everyday essentials, they were able to prepare for life with twins.

Today, these once-tiny babies are thriving, healthy little boys with personalities all their own. Though they may look alike, their temperaments are already beautifully unique. Kayli laughed as she shared that she dresses them in different outfits just to tell them apart.

Looking back, Kayli says those early days feel like a blur, but what stands out clearly is how supported she felt. Through every appointment, every class, and every conversation, she gained confidence. *"Alpha Center made me feel ready to be a mom."*
